(Junior) Violet Sinishtaj, from our Varsity Girls' Golf team. In our only contest this week, Violet, shot an 85 to place 13th out of 80 golfers at the KLAA Pre-Conference Tournament at Kensington Golf Course.

(Sophomore) Riley Hough, from our Varsity Boy's Cross Country team. Riley led the Hartland cross Country team to a second place finish at the Rambling Rock Invitational. He finished 1st overall in time of 15:34. He also set the meet record.

(Junior) Audrey Brown, from our Varsity Girls' Golf team. Audrey is a 3-year varsity player. On Wednesday at Hartland Glen, she shot a 46 to help us to a victory over Plymouth Salem. At the Farmington Invitational Tournament Friday held at Glen Oaks Golf Course, she shot a personal best 79 and was a top 15 medalist out of 125 golfers!

Annabelle achieved her MISCA qualifying time in the 50 free with the time of 26.18 at Fenton Relays on Saturday, as the lead off swimmer in the 200 free relay helping Hartland finish 4th in that relay. She also helped Hartland to place 7th and 4th in other Relays. Then in the final Spees Sprint relay, she improved her 50 free time once again as the lead off swimmer with a 26.13 and helped Hartland gain 4th place.
