### **PRESIDENT'S REPORT:**

Mr. Hughes presented Hartland Happenings, with a brainstorming session at the end, about future needs for the school district. There is a published powerpoint available on the HCS website.

He also mentioned that:

- HCS will be purchasing 7 new buses, at the cost of \$100,000 a piece.
- Sixty eight (68)% of the HCS budget is spent on students and instruction. The budget can be viewed as a table, with each leg representing employee retention, fund balance, curriculum and facility maintenance.
- SAT levels show HCS students scoring 14-24% higher than the state average.
- MSTEP-Creekside Elementary (CES) scored 70% and above in all testing areas.
- 3.2 million dollars are spent in transportation
- Only 7% of the lottery funds go into school fund.
- Only 2% of the 6% sales tax should go into the school fund.
