

# JUNIOR PSAT : SATURDAY, OCTOBER 13

The PSAT is a great way to get additional practice before the SAT. This is a full-length test, so you will experience similar test format and questions as what you'll see when you take the SAT in April. Most importantly, this will help identify some areas of strength and weakness so you can better prepare for the April test.

Colleges do not have access to these scores, but if you score highly enough, you may qualify for the National Merit Scholarship Program. The October PSAT is the only way for Juniors to be eligible for this prestigious and competitive scholarship.

Students receive scores back from College Board shortly after Thanksgiving and are given back their test booklets and answer key for use in SAT preparation. In addition, they will receive a code to use online through Khan Academy to personalize their SAT preparation. Khan Academy is a highly recommended tool, even for students who do not take the PSAT.

2. Click on Parents at the top of the screen
3. Click on PayForIt and login
4. Click on your 11<sup>th</sup> grader's name
5. Click on Fees, scroll down to find PSAT, and click the green X
6. Proceed to pay

OR: Bring a check to the front office

**The deadline to register is September 14<sup>th</sup>.** After that, you'll be placed on a waitlist and contacted if a spot opens.

Important: Because the test booklets must be pre-ordered and paid for, it is important that the student commit to this date if signing up. The school is responsible for all test materials, even if they go unused. **Therefore, refunds cannot be issued after Friday, September 14<sup>th</sup>.**
