

HHS Student Driving and Parking Regulations for 2020-2021

Student Parking Eligibility

- HHS Senior or Junior Students
- Sophomores if spaces are available after offered to all upper classman
- 16 years old w/ valid driver's license
- Current Michigan vehicle registration and automobile insurance
- No outstanding school fines

Process of Purchasing Student Parking Pass

- Complete the parking permit application (HHS Website->Parents->Registration) using your HHS student email.
- You will be invoiced on PayForIt.net (ensure your PayForIt account has email notification enabled).
- Pay for your Parking Pass on PayForIt.net. We will assign a fee once approved.

Parking Permit Guidelines

- Parking permits are issued to ONE student and are NOT TRANSFERABLE.
- Students can only park in their assigned spot with a registered vehicle (students can register up to 3 vehicles).
- Students must display their parking permit hang tag at all times.
- If you drive an unregistered vehicle, you must report it to the security desk upon arrival.
- Students with a valid HHS parking permit and handicap tag, may park in a handicap parking spot.
- Students must stop at all security checkpoints as directed.
- Student vehicles parked on campus are subject to search and seizure at any time, including canine searches.
- Students may not sit in their vehicles on campus during the school day.
- Students must follow all other rules as outlined in the HHS Secondary School Handbook.

Permit Costs

- \$50.00 for the Parking Permit (Price reduced from \$75.00 for this year only due to COVID-19).
- \$5.00 charge to replace misplaced or lost Hang Tag

Parking Violations Fees

- No parking permit displayed - \$5
- Driving an unregistered vehicle – \$30
- Parking in a handicap parking spot -\$30
- Parking in a no parking zone - \$30
- Parking in a reserved space or area - \$30
- Parking in two spaces - \$30
- Blocking driveway or access (fire lane/end of row) - \$50
- Tampering or falsifying a parking permit - \$30
- Parking in Staff Lot, Pool Lot, Receiving or by Auto Shop - \$30
- Careless or reckless driving - \$50 and suspension of parking privileges

Multiple or severe violations of HHS parking rules can result in the following consequences in addition to the fees listed above:

- Suspension/Loss of parking privileges
- Vehicle towed at owner expense
- Student discipline in accordance with the HHS Student Handbook

Appeals of parking violations must be made within 15 school days of the violation in the main office.

By providing the school district with this application, the student and parent/guardian agree that the vehicle described will remain properly licensed and insured so as to operate under the laws of the State of Michigan. The registered owner will be responsible for any damages done by his/her vehicle. Students are expected to read the additional information regarding Driving and Parking located in the Driving Automobiles section in the Parent-Student Handbook.
