



Graduation Requirements

- A student must successfully complete...
 - 25 credits, which include:
 - 4 years of English
 - 4 years of Math
 - 3 years of Science
 - 3 years of Social Studies
 - 2 years of World Language
 - ½ credit of Health
 - ½ credit of Physical Conditioning
 - 1 credit of Visual, Performing Arts
 - An Online Learning Experience

Where does your student stand?

- Minimum 18 credits earned by beginning of 12th grade to be on track to graduate
 - $18 + 7 = 25$ (3.5 credits 1st sem & 3.5 credits 2nd sem)
- Credit status letters will be mailed home by mid-October
- Students must have successfully completed 25 credits – including all required classes – in order to participate in the graduation ceremony



 - Only accepted by MSU & University of Michigan

 - October 5th - 9th, 2020

Letters of Recommendation

- Some colleges & scholarships will require a letter of recommendation
- Students should ask someone who knows them well – teacher, coach, club sponsor, etc.
- They should also have a letter of recommendation from a teacher in the subject they plan to study
- Give the person writing your letter a minimum of 2 weeks notice
Submit to Counseling and Teachers no later than:
 - **October 16th** for November 1st application deadlines
 - **December 4th** for January 1st application deadlines
- Provide a resume outlining your accomplishments and extracurricular involvement

is used for:



- Some schools require a FAFSA on file to be considered for internal scholarships/aid


