Dear Parents,

This letter contains important information about registering for 2017 AP Exams. Hartland High School will be offering select AP tests during the month of May. Students take these examinations in hopes of receiving Advanced Placement credits for college. You can view extensive information about the AP exams at [www.collegeboard.com](http://www.collegeboard.com).

We will be using the Total Registration website to order AP exams. Total Registration will allow you the flexibility to purchase the exams with credit cards, debit cards, or by mailing them a check. This organization will also help with communication, as it will e-mail parents and students room assignments (when they are made), and include an option to allow students to receive text messages with important reminders.

For the 2017 AP exams, students who choose to purchase AP Exams will need to register online between **Thursday, February 2, 2017 and Sunday, February 19, 2017 at 11:59 PM. 2017 Advanced Placement exams cost \$99.00 per exam.** Families who qualify for free/reduced lunch will be able to request financial assistance through the website and receive a reduced rate.

A late registration period will take place from February 20 until February 28. A \$20 late fee will be added to the exam cost during late registration.

In order to register, students should click on the link provided on the Hartland High School Counseling website or visit [www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/231900](http://www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/231900) to register. To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end. We know that parents may desire to register their students for exams; however we strongly recommend that parents and students are both present while registering to ensure that the correct exams are selected. Some exams have very similar names.

Here are the important dates for the registration process:

- Thursday, February 2, 2017 at 7:00 AM - Registration Begins
- Sunday, February 19, 2017 until 11:59 PM - Last day to register without paying late fee penalty
- Monday, Feb 20, 2017 at 12:01 AM - Registrations and payments after this date/time will incur a \$20 late fee per exam.
- Tuesday, February 28, 2017 at 11:59 PM - Late Registration Ends
- Monday, April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2017 after school or during 4<sup>th</sup> hour for those unable to stay after school will be a mandatory pre-administration session for any students signing up for an AP exam.

Please note that all refunds will be coordinated through Total Registration. **To get a refund you must log into your Total Registration Account and cancel your exam.** To receive a **full refund**, you must log in and **cancel your exams by February 28, 2017.**



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If you cancel your exam between March 1, 2017 and May 12, 2017 you will receive a refund of \$74.00, after all exams have been administered (\$15.00 is retained by College Board \$5.00 goes toward proctors hired, and \$5.00 covers our cost to use the online registration service.) Students who purchase an exam in February, but do not show up for the exam on the test date in May must go back into their registration account online and cancel before their scheduled exam time ends, in order to get a refund. After May 12, 2017 there will be no refunds as we must pay College-Board the full amount.

The dates and times of the exams are below for your reference. Most exams will be held at the Hartland Educational Student Services Center, located on M-59. Students are expected to make arrangements for transportation in advance of their test date. Students will be excused from school the full day of their scheduled exam. More information regarding room assignments will be given toward the end of April.
