Xello an internet-based career exploration and planning tool used to explore career and college options and develop a career plan.

EDP Educational Development Plan (EDP) are living documents developed by all students to identify career goals and related act<mark>ion plans in alignment with their changing interests and abilities.</mark>

Youth Employment Fair an annual one-day event held at LESA that connects students and employers from across Livingston County and provides students the chance to meet local employers, learn about their businesses, and possible career opportunities.

MiCareer Quest held in Oakland County, this is the region's largest interactive career exploration event for high school students. It exposes students to a broad range of exciting and rewarding career opportunities as they prepare for their futures.

CTE Night an open house style event held yearly at Hartland High School. This event showcases the CTE programs that we have in our building. Work industry representatives and college admissions officers join our staff to provide insight to parents and students.

DECA an organization students can participate in that prepares emerging leaders and entrepreneurs for careers in marketing, finance, hospitality and management in high schools and colleges around the globe.

WRAP a program for special education students where they have the ability to explore career interests in the field. The program focuses on safety awareness, students understanding their own IEP (Individual Education Plan), independent living skills, and understanding the difference between hard and soft skills. The program is run through Michigan Rehabilitation Services. It stands for Work Readiness Assessment Program.

ASVAB the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a multiple-aptitude battery that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military. It is administered annually to more than one million military applicants, high school, and post-secondary students.

Livingston Early College a program that allows students to earn 30-60 college credits in high school with free tuition and books. In their senior year (grade 12), most programs start with a full college schedule, while others are an integration of college and high school courses. Students will have continual guidance in adjusting to college deadlines and calendars as they go through the program. They will also learn to advocate for themselves and transition into a college student. Students will postpone receiving their high school diploma until they complete their 13th year of school. In year 13, they continue with a full college schedule, complete a 40-hour internship, and gain knowledge about learning and career opportunities. Your students' local school district covers the cost of tuition and books.

Job Shadow Day over 50 employers are providing high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to experience a day in the life of different career paths, ranging from business management to speech pathologists to robotics technicians and many more. This one-day activity provides students with insights into what it's like to be part of different workplaces and careers in the county and surrounding areas. Employers will meet students who are interested in their respective fields and explore possibilities for their next steps.

Shared Time Programs Career and Technical Education (CTE) programs in Livingston County operate as a consortium, meaning the five local school districts (Brighton, Fowlerville, Hartland, Howell, and Pinckney) work together to offer students local opportunities, as well as encouraging students to enroll in programs outside of their home high school.
