# What is an Honors Course?

# What is an AP Class

AP stands for Advanced Placement. Students who take AP Classes can possibly earn college credit for the course. Credit is determined by each individual college based on the students AP Exam, given by CollegeBoard.

# GPA

Honors & Regular Courses, non-weighted

A = 4.0

AP Courses, weighted, 5.0 scale

A = 5.0
