## Important Information for Incoming Freshman

### **ENROLLMENT**

Parents of students who plan to attend Hartland High School for the 2022-2023 school year that are not currently enrolled in Hartland Consolidated Schools need to go to the HCS District website to complete the online enrollment packet and, if applicable, the online School of Choice application.

5. If applicable - Complete the School of Choice Application

We have made a series of videos for our incoming freshman students and families. One of those videos is specifically geared toward new families and provides further instruction regarding enrollment, as well as the contact information needed to make an appointment with the students' respective high school counselors. Families **must bring** an official birth certificate (with the raised seal), proof of residency or school or choice approval letter/email, immunization record and the student's most recent 8th grade report card or transcript. Students will not be able to register for ninth grade classes until they have met with their counselor. It is encouraged that families meet with their Hartland High School counselor between **March 1st - March 25th** for optimal class availability.

### **FRESHMEN ORIENTATION & Registration (LINK)**

LINK is a half-day event that will take place in August. Next year's LINK date is tentatively scheduled to be held on August 8, 2022 from 7:45 AM to approximately 1:00 PM. Students will interact with upperclassmen leaders in large & small groups through a curriculum designed to help them prepare for high school. They will also receive their class schedules, locker information, get their school picture taken, turn in registration paperwork, & tour the school at this time.
