




# Yearbook Online Ordering

    - 2 years of World Language
    - 1/2 credit of Health
    - 1/2 credit of Physical Conditioning
    - 1 credit of Visual, Performing Arts

## Where does your student stand?

- Minimum 18 credits earned by beginning of 12<sup>th</sup> grade to be on track to graduate
   18 + 7 = 25 (3.5 credits 1<sup>st</sup> sem & 3.5 credits 2<sup>nd</sup> sem)
- Credit status letters will be mailed home by the end of September
- Students must have successfully completed 25 credits – including all required classes – in order to participate in the graduation ceremony

## Letters of Recommendation

- Some colleges & scholarships will require them
- Ask someone who knows you well (teacher, coach, boss, etc.)
- If possible, ask a teacher in the subject you plan to study
- Give the recommender at least 2 weeks notice
  - October 15th for November 1<sup>st</sup> application deadlines
  - December 3rd for January 1<sup>st</sup> application deadlines
- Provide a resume outlining your accomplishments and extracurricular involvement
  - Requesting recommendations from Counseling
    - Google form and pdf versions
    - HHS Homepage → Counseling → Senior Quick Links →College Applications
